- **John Schultz Leadership Award:** This award was developed as a special Rochester PTA Council Founders Day award to honor retired Superintendent, Dr. John Schultz. Dr. Schultz was the Rochester Community Schools (RCS) Superintendent for 22 years. He provided leadership in areas of curriculum development, technology, finance and special education. His expertise in strategic planning helped RCS maintain an outstanding reputation during a period of rapid growth in enrollment and declining revenue resources. He was a fervent supporter of PTA since his early days as a teacher in our district and Dr. Schultz met regularly with PTA Council Executive officers to ensure that a true partnership exists between parents and the school district. This award is given to a PTA/PTSA member who emulates Dr. Schultz's leadership & commitment to the PTA. The winner of this award will receive:
 - A certificate of recognition, his/her name on the Dr. John Schultz Leadership Award plaque kept in the RCS Administration Building
 - Payment of his/her registration fee for the Michigan PTA Convention or a contribution to the PTA Council Scholarship Fund
- **Council Advocacy Award:** The Council Advocacy Award may be given to a PTA/PTSA member who has shown tireless dedication to the cause of advocating for every child.
- **Council Member of the Year Award:** To honor a PTA/PTSA member who has shown outstanding leadership at the council level, a commitment to children's advocacy and a genuine passion for PTA.
- **The Distinguished Service Award:** The Distinguished Service Award may be given to a PTA/PTSA member who has shown tireless dedication to the cause and extraordinary service on behalf of children and youth. 3 awards are given each year.
- **The Bright Ideas Award:** The Bright Ideas Award may be given to a PTA/PTSA member or a PTA/PTSA group who has implemented an innovative idea from which many or every school can benefit.
- **ACORN Award:** The ACORN Award is given to a PTSA student for his/her service, advocacy and leadership.
